Rainy Day Celebration

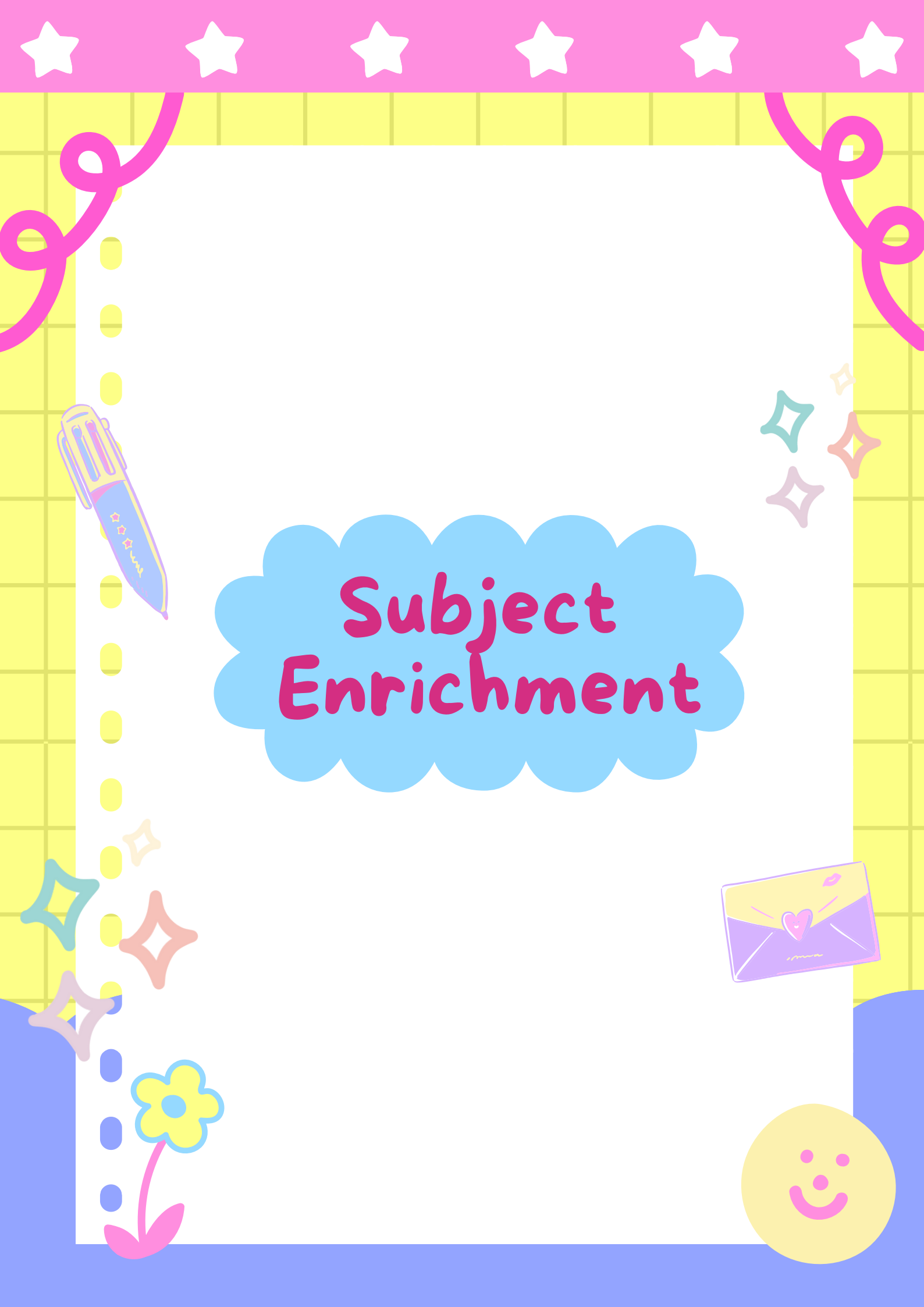
Rainy day is always a fun time for the kids if it is celebrated in the school, it makes the school environment light and enjoyable.

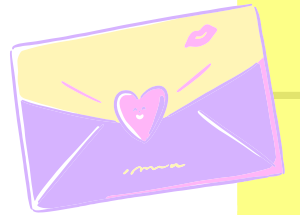
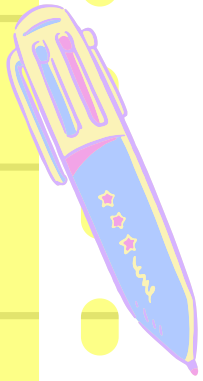
The kids had a free play time with their peer group. They jumped in the puddle and splashed in the water.

Let's make Caterpillar with this Fingertip Print Counting Activity..

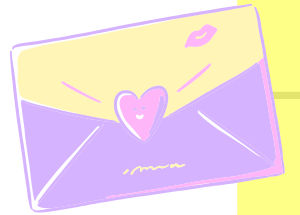
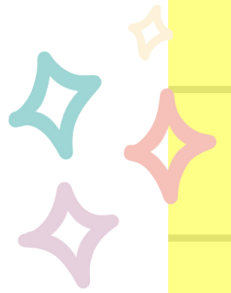
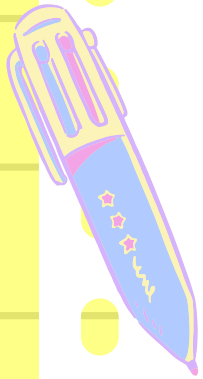

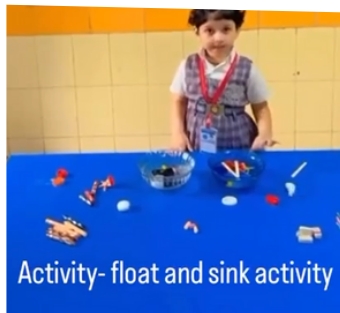
Threading pasta into Noodle Necklaces is also a great activity for fine motor development and eye-hand coordination.

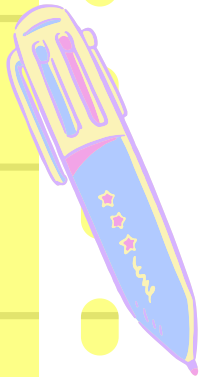


Topic: Float & Sink

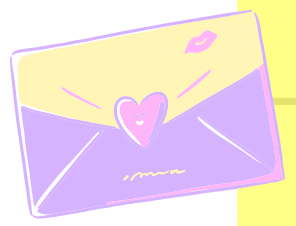
Little minds at work!!!!

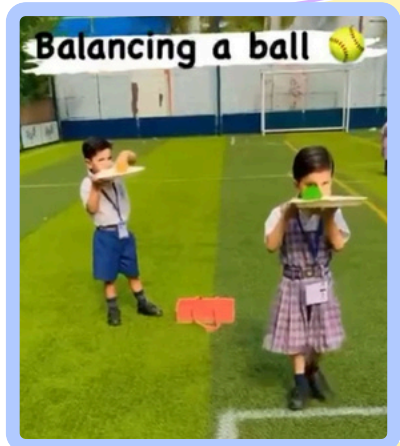
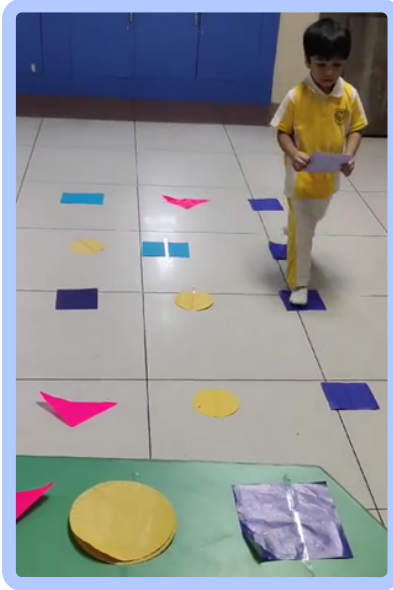
Non-Scholastic Activities
